Hau'oli Makahiki Hou! There are many changes to be had at the Kainalu library to start 2012. Titles have been added to the print collection; please take a look at the new books on the shelves as you enter the library and throughout the collection. Access to more electronic resources has also been obtained. Every student now has free access to the online versions of the Encyclopedia Britannica and EBSCO, a database of journal and magazine articles, ebooks and audio books.

Students can get access to the databases in several ways:

- Click the links at the bottom of the front page of the school library catalog:

Every students' user ID and password are the same:

- USER ID: kainalues
- PASSWORD: kainalues

Another great way to do online research is through the 'WebPath Express' link from the library's catalog page. It acts like a search engine, instead of Google or Bing, but provides links to educational websites at appropriate grade levels. Just click on the WebPath express tab on the left from the school library's catalog page. Happy researching!
